On Tuesday, October 19, Cambridge At Home will travel to Southern Maine, starting in Brunswick with a guided tour of the recently – and imaginatively -- renovated Bowdoin College Art Museum, whose collections are among the most comprehensive of any college art museum in the country. We will then drive to Portland, where we will have lunch at David's Restaurant on Monument Square, one of the outstanding eateries that make Portland a destination for New England gourmets. Following lunch, we will tour the Portland Museum of Art, whose I.M. Pei-designed Payson Building showcases American art from the post- Revolutionary period to the 1910s, with a special emphasis on the works of Winslow Homer.

All told, the day will highlight the region's artistic and literary history, as we enjoy the fragrance of pine forests and the expansive vistas along the rocky shores of Southern Maine. Do join us -- and bring a friend!
